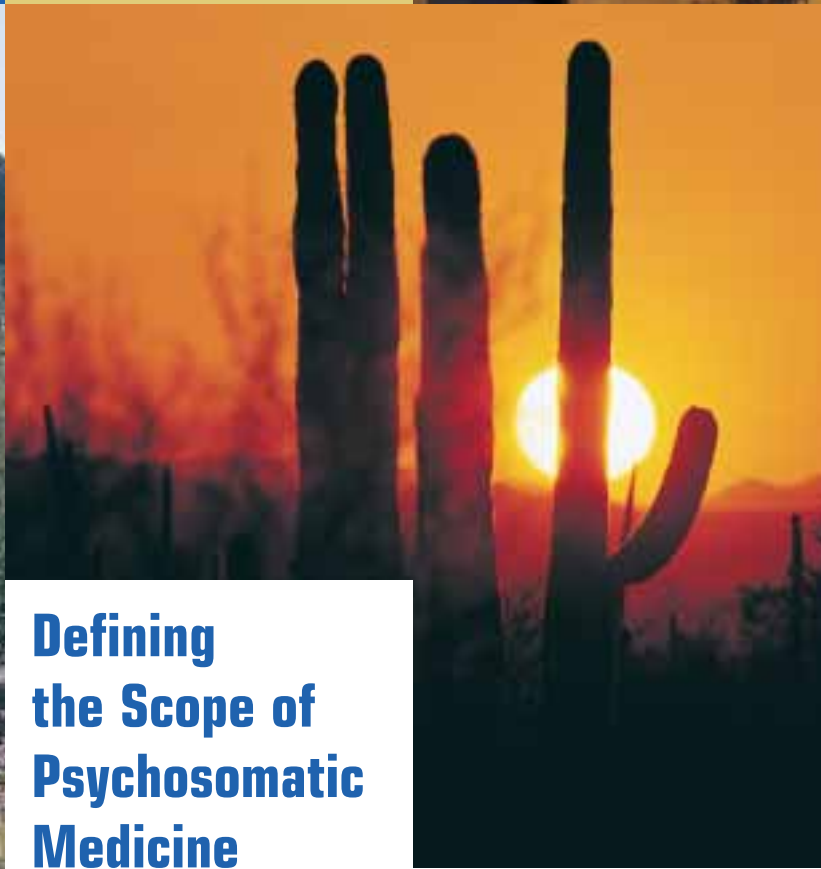

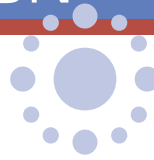

We are pleased to welcome you to the 53rd Annual Meeting of the Academy of Psychosomatic Medicine in Tucson, Arizona. We offer a special welcome to our international members, the American Psychosomatic Society and first-time attendees. We hope you will find the meeting to be the unique combination of scholarship and camaraderie that have always characterized this special yearly event of the Academy. Our eager expectation is that this year's program will once again showcase the outstanding clinical, educational and research activity of our subspecialty. The record number of submissions this year reflects the dynamic growth of the field since achieving subspecialty status.



This year's program is centered on the theme of "*Defining the Scope of Psychosomatic Medicine*" and will explore some of the many issues raised by our new formal identity. While we have generally been pretty clear about our roles and responsibilities as C-L psychiatrists in the past, our new ACGME designation as specialists in Psychosomatic Medicine offers us some new opportunities and challenges. A number of presentations throughout the meeting,

beginning with the first ever Presidential Address and Presidential Symposium, will address these prospects.

Contributing to the discussion and enriching the program will be presentations by the American Psychosomatic Society. Their invitation to join us speaks to our newly invigorated, mutual desire to explore potential areas of synergy and collaboration.

Scientific meetings are dynamic entities and we have made some programming changes that reflect our continuing growth. The large number of submissions has led to a total of 184 presentations this year distributed across 11 workshops, 16 symposia, 21 papers, 59 posters and other special lectures. We have added an evening program of workshops on Thursday, November 16, expanded the number of paper tracks from 4 to 5 on Saturday, November 18, and introduced a Fellowship Forum and Master Clinician Seminar. Together, the program, carefully assembled by our highly qualified scientific program committee, represents the latest contributions of the international community of clinicians and researchers in Consultation-Liaison Psychiatry and Psychosomatic Medicine.

This year we have also expanded our social activities to include a bar night on Friday and a stargazing reception on Saturday night. We hope you will enjoy our planned programming, the spectacular setting of the Loews Ventana Canyon Resort, and the many splendors of Tucson.

COURSE 1:

Salons D&E

WEDNESDAY, NOVEMBER 15, 2006, 2:00 – 6:00 PM
Psychotherapy of the Medically Ill

This combined course will present two different psychotherapeutic approaches to working with medically ill patients in separate two-hour presentations.

1. Cognitive Therapy for Medically Ill Patients will describe the systematic applications of cognitive principles to treat the medically ill. It will provide a strong conceptual understanding of the basic tenets of cognitive therapy, meta-analytic studies of its efficacy, and practical techniques that can be used in everyday clinical work.

Faculty: **Tomer Levin, MD** is a full time psycho-oncologist and cognitive therapist at Memorial Sloan Kettering Cancer Center. Dr. Levin trained in cognitive therapy at the Beck Institute in Philadelphia and is a member of the Academy of Cognitive Therapy. He is an Assistant Professor of Psychiatry and Behavioral Sciences at Memorial Sloan-Kettering Cancer Center.

2. The Psychoanalytically Informed Approach to the Medically Ill

This course will provide an overview of a psychoanalytically informed psychodynamic approach to the hospitalized medically ill. The emphasis will be on

how to think about clinical situations, from a psychodynamic perspective, by utilizing clinical experiences provided by participants and the instructor. Topics will include psychodynamic assessment and diagnostic concepts, using the new *Psychodynamic Diagnostic Manual*, the importance of grief and mourning, and countertransference and empathy in the medically ill.

Faculty: **Craig Lichtman, MD, MBA**, is a Clinical Assistant Professor of Psychiatry at the University of Pennsylvania School of Medicine and is on the faculty of the Institute of the Psychoanalytic Center of Philadelphia. He has maintained a solo private practice of consultation-liaison psychiatry in a general medical/surgical hospital for twenty years, as well as his private practice of psychotherapy and psychoanalysis.

COURSE 2:

Sonora

WEDNESDAY, NOVEMBER 15, 2006, 2:00 – 6:00 PM
ECT in the Medically Ill

This course will address the use of ECT for medically ill patients in the general hospital. It will examine the appropriate diagnosis and prescreening assessment necessary for ECT. The course will describe the medical issues that may complicate the provision of ECT. It will also highlight the steps that can be taken to provide safer and effective ECT for the medically ill patient. Finally, it will present current controversies in the provision of ECT and review the literature on electrode placement, stimulus dosing and cognitive side effects.

Faculty: **Donald A. Malone, Jr., MD, FAPM**, is a staff psychiatrist at The Cleveland Clinic Foundation, and Section Head of Adult Primary Psychiatric Services and Director of the Psychiatric Neuromodulation Center. Dr. Malone is currently President of The Association for Convulsive Therapy.

Leo Pozuelo, MD, FACP, is a staff psychiatrist at the Cleveland Clinic and is the Section Head of Consultation-Liaison Psychiatry and Associate Director of the Bakken Heart Brain Institute. Dr Pozuelo is certified by the Association for Convulsive Therapy.
