CRITERIA FOR ELIGIBILITY

Academy members who manifest additional, active participation as educators, researchers, or administrators in the fields of consultation-liaison psychiatry and psychosomatic medicine. To qualify for consideration as a Fellow, a candidate must:

1. Be a member in good standing of the Academy for five years and have completed a training program three years prior to election to Fellowship. (If APM member prior to 2004, must have been a member in good standing for a period of three years.)
2. Have attended at least one APM Annual Meeting in the last three years prior to applying for Fellowship.
3. Have received certification in Psychosomatic Medicine, or their country's equivalent, if applicable. (Exceptions will be considered on a case-by-case basis.)
4. Show excellence in at least four of the five areas (I–V) outlined on the reverse as demonstrated by C.V. and other documentation.
5. Be sponsored by two Academy Fellows who must send a letter of recommendation on your behalf to the APM Fellowship Committee.
6. Be approved by the Fellowship Committee and by the Executive Council.
7. Submit a copy of your C.V. with this application, plus copies of title pages or table of contents for journal articles, title pages for books, and letters of appointment for society and administrative offices.
8. Attend an Annual Meeting Convocation in order to be installed to Fellowship.

In order to be considered for installation at the Fall Annual Meeting, the candidate must have provided the above information **by August 1** of that year. Only Fellows qualify for election to Council and as Academy officers.

In a letter to the Academy Fellowship Committee, please describe your activities in each of the following areas.

I. Teaching

1. Undergraduate (medical school) education programs
2. Graduate (residency and fellowship) education programs
3. Continuing medical education or other medically related teaching
4. Supervision at the graduate or postgraduate level

II. Administration

1. Administrative responsibilities for consultation-liaison services
2. Special liaison activities
3. Other administrative positions related to consultation-liaison or psychosomatic medicine

III. Scientific Activity

1. Recent publications in consultation-liaison psychiatry, psychosomatic medicine, or related areas
2. Recent presentations in these areas at regional or national meetings
3. Grants in these areas

IV. Society Memberships and Activities

1. List memberships and activities
2. Committee assignments in these organizations
3. Offices or other positions held in these organizations
